- Holding a doctoral degree (PhD) in technical sciences in the discipline of Architecture and Urban Planning
- Possession of unrestricted architecture design licence
- Possession of pedagogical qualifications or completion of such training during the first year of employment;
- Experience in conducting academic classes in architectural and urban design at a technical university
- A minimum of 5 years of professional experience as an architect or lead architect in projects of various scales
- Proficiency in the English language sufficient to conduct academic classes
- Documented fluency in the Polish language (applicable to foreign nationals)

2. Additional requirements:

- Experience in conducting scientific research or a publication record in engineering and technical sciences within the discipline of Architecture and Urban Planning
- Participation in research projects, particularly those financed from external sources
- Participation in architectural competitions, including award-winning or commended projects
- Participation in the organization of exhibitions and scientific conferences
- Knowledge of modern CAD/BIM design tools

3. Scope of tasks performed/job description (responsibilities and entitlements):

- Conducting teaching activities and student consultations in the scope defined by the Work Regulations of the Cracow University of Technology
- Active participation in the teaching and organizational work of the unit
- Participation in scientific and teaching seminars
- Participation in training sessions aimed at professional development
- Applying for grants
- Other tasks assigned by the direct supervisor
- Preparation and archiving of documentation within the unit

4. Description of working conditions, we offer, among other things,
