Cracow University of Technology ANNOUNCES A COMPETITION FOR THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT IN THE GROUP OF TEACHING STAFF

in the Department of History of Architecture and Monument Conservation A-01

Proportion of work time: Full-time Number of positions available: 1

Type of employment contract: fixed term of 12 months

Scientific discipline represented: Architecture and Urban Planning

Organizational unit: Department of History of Architecture and Monument Conservation

1. Essential requirements:

- 1) A doctoral degree (PhD) in technical sciences in the discipline of architecture and urban planning
- 2) Proficiency in English sufficient to conduct teaching
- 3) Proficiency in Polish sufficient to conduct teaching activities
- 4) Willingness to conduct scientific research and actively participate in the academic life of the Department and Faculty
- 5) Possession of an unlimited design license in construction

2. Additional requirements:

- 1) Documented scientific achievements, including publications in highly ranked scientific journals
- 2) Experience in conducting or co-conducting national or international research projects/grants
- 3) Experience in scientific or conservation project implementation
- 4) Possession of pedagogical qualifications or a commitment to obtain them during the first year of employment





- 5) Proficiency in using specialized graphic or research software (e.g., AutoCAD, SketchUp, Revit, EXCEL Adobe)
- 6) Participation in national and international scientific conferences

3. Scope of tasks performed/job description (duties and powers):

- 1) Conducting teaching activities and student consultations in accordance with the Cracow University of Technology's work regulations
- 2) Active participation in the unit's research activities and teaching duties
- 3) Participation in academic and teaching seminars
- 4) Active involvement in the organizational work of the department
- 5) Participation in training aimed at professional development
- 6) Applying for research grants
- 7) Other tasks assigned by the immediate supervisor.

4. Description of working conditions, we offer, among other things:

- 1) a friendly workplace at a university with an established reputation
- 2) cooperation with the scientific community represented by recognized scientists
- 3) academic support and the opportunity for skill enhancement and professional development
- 4) access to research infrastructure
- 5) additional days off (5-9 days per year) depending on the calendar
- 6) additional annual remuneration (so-called 13th salary)
- 7) additional and optional group insurance and preferential medical care
- 8) subsidized recreation of employees and their children, the so-called "grusza" benefit
- 9) subsidies for sports and recreational activities (card, pass) and cultural and educational activities
- 10) subsidies for childcare (nursery, kindergarten, or children's club)
- 11) organizing day camps for employees' children
- 12) granting low-interest loans for housing purposes
- 13) access to the Employee Mutual Aid Fund

5. Career development prospects:

1) Receiving a positive annual performance evaluation in a teaching role may result in promotion to a research assistant professor





2) The Faculty of Architecture supports academic advancement and has the right to confer post-doctoral (habilitation) degrees in the field of technical sciences in the discipline of architecture and urban planning

6. Required documentation:

- 1) Application addressed to the Rector
- 2) Detailed CV (including employment history).
- 3) List of achievements, major publications, unpublished works, and any other documents relevant to employment.
- 4) Copies of documents confirming educational qualifications.
- 5) Copies of other documents confirming professional qualifications or skills, including language proficiency.
- 6) Certificate of completion of a pedagogical course or a declaration to complete it within the first year of employment.
- 7) Personal questionnaire (available on the CUT website "Jobs at CUT" tab)

Employment will take place after a competitive **process in accordance with Chapter VI. Phases of the Recruitment Procedure, OTM-R Policy, consisting of:**

- analysis of the submitted documentation,
- conducting interviews (face-to-face or via instant messaging software),

The required documents should be submitted to the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Architecture of the Cracow University of Technology (ul.
